Students seeking admission to the North Georgia Technical College Associate of Science Degree in Nursing program must be admitted to North Georgia Technical College (See NGTC website for college admission information). Additionally, students will need to complete the ASN Intent Form (this page) and return to the address below between January 1 and 5:00pm April 1. Intent Forms submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

Minimum admission standards for the ASN program include:

- Students interested in the ASN program will be placed in the Interdisciplinary Studies: Specialization in Nursing program (or other acceptable program) upon acceptance to the college. Students must be either a current or former (within the academic year) Interdisciplinary Studies (or acceptable program) student and have an intent form on file for the upcoming cohort. Once students have been selected for the cohort, they will be placed in the ASN program.
Completed ASN Intent Form (this page) submitted by the deadline of 5:00pm, September 1st
Official copies of all transcripts from other schools must be submitted to NGTC by September 1st. Transcripts for coursework taken summer semester at colleges other than NGTC must be received by September 15th.
Completion of required core courses.
The required core courses are outlined in the North Georgia Technical College Catalog/Student Handbook. This information can also be found on the Frequently Asked Questions document.
A minimum 3.0 Cumulative GPA must be achieved for required core courses (=average of final grades for the required core). GPA calculations are based on the most recent attempt of credit hours for the required core courses.
Completion of the HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam. Only the first two attempts on the HESI Assessment Exam (within the 12 month period prior to the intent form due date) will be considered in the competitive process. The HESI must be taken on one of the NGTC campuses. Exam dates are posted on the Continuing Education page under courses available.

Admission to the nursing program is competitive. The number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. Meeting minimum admissions standards does not guarantee acceptance. Applicants' scores on the HESI and GPA based on required core courses will be ranked from the highest to the lowest. Students with the highest combined scores will be admitted based on the number of available seats in the cohort. In the event that it becomes necessary to break a tie, the following criteria will be considered:

- Employment experience in a healthcare field.
- Completion of educational degree (associates, bachelors, masters)
- Completion of additional courses required for graduation from ASN program but not included in core curriculum (PSYC 1101, PSYC 2103 ENGL 1102, and one humanities course such as ARTS 1101, ENGL 2130 or MUSC 1101)

HESI Admission Assessment Exam (A2)

Completion of the HESI exam.

- HESI examination scores are available at the conclusion of the test.
- For scoring purposes the HESI exam scores will be retrieved directly from the testing company, Elsevier.
- No more than two attempts of the HESI may be taken within one year of the Intent to Apply due date. (September 1st)
- The HESI exam must be taken on one of the NGTC campuses

Registration Information:

- To register for the exam, call the testing office at 706-754-7716, contact lfoster@northgatech.edu, or the Blairsville testing office at 706-439-6334.

Location

- The HESI Exam is administered on the Clarkesville and Blairsville Campuses.

HESI Exam information:

- Arrive prior to check-in time.
- Bring earphones for use during the test.
- Photo identification is required. Driver's license or school ID is acceptable.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the testing room, bathroom breaks are permissible.
- Do not bring your cell phone or calculator to the test (calculators are enabled on the computer).

Additional information:

- Students must meet the minimum admission standards to be considered for admission to the ASN program. Completion of the HESI does not guarantee admission to the program.
- Nursing acceptance/denial letters will be mailed by June 15th.
