

Pell Grant Lifetime Limit Acknowledgement

In December 2011, the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2012 (Public Law 112-74) was signed into law. This law has significantly impacted the Pell Grant Program. Beginning with the Fall 2012 semester, students are now limited to 12 semesters (or 600%) of Pell Grant eligibility during their lifetime. This affects all students regardless of when or where they received their first Pell Grant.
