



## STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT 2019

Based on Academic Year 2019 credit enrollment

### Enrollment

3,606 students enrolled in credit courses at NGTC during Academic Year 2019. This was the Full Time Equivalent (FTE) of 1,825 students (based on the sum of total credit hours for all students).

The college's **Student Retention Rate is 67.9%** (based on first-time, regular admitted students enrolled in Fall 2017, who graduated or were still enrolled in a Georgia technical college or University System college as of the end of the next year, Academic Year 2019).

**34.8%** of students attended college full time, and **65.2%** attended part time (based on fall semester 2018).
