



TUITION & FEES SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

April 26, 2018 for assistance with Summer 2018 Semester

July 20, 2018 for assistance with Fall 2018 Semester

November 20, 2018 for assistance with Spring 2019 Semester

*** ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP – READ BELOW ***

YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE IF:

- you are not registered for at least one class for the upcoming semester.
 - you are on warning or probation of any kind - you must be in good academic standing.
 - you have a GPA lower than 2.0 at the time of application – GPA must be 2.0 or higher.
 - you do not have an APPROVED FAFSA on file with the NGTC Financial Aid Office at time of application.
 - you do not provide the name and email of an **Instructor** or **Employer** to provide a recommendation.
 - you do not **complete and submit your application by the deadline listed above**.
 - you received a refund the previous semester for unused financial aid funds of **any** kind.
 - you are not eligible to receive PELL funds due to your/your parents income level being too high (determined by FAFSA).
- Scholarships are awarded in amounts **UP TO \$375** (based on credit hours registered for).
 - **ALL** funds are paid directly to NGTC - **NO** checks will be issued to students - **NO reimbursements** will be made for charges paid by a student prior to being notified of scholarship award. **All other aid (any kind) must be used prior to any scholarship funds being applied.**
 - **Foundation Scholarships are based on financial need** – IF your FAFSA determines that you are not eligible to receive PELL funds due to your (or your parents) income level, you are not eligible for a scholarship.
 - Students must apply each semester – applications do not carry over to the next semester.

THE SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS: (1) We receive your application. (2) We contact the reference you provided. (3) We check financial aid information, academic standing, etc. through the Financial Aid Office. (4) Applications are evaluated by the Foundation Scholarship Committee. (5) Applicants are notified via the email address they provide as to whether or not an award has been made. (The process MAY take up to TWO weeks following the application deadline. Please check your email regularly for your notification.) (6) The business office will be notified to apply the scholarship to your account.

Only applicants with a balance owed after ALL other aid funds are applied will receive scholarship funds. Completion of an application does not guarantee a scholarship award.

AGREEMENT: READ the following statement carefully and SIGN your application indicating understanding and agreement:

I understand that in order to be considered for a scholarship I must: (1) be accepted for admission to NGTC, (2) have an approved FAFSA & all supporting documents on file with the Financial Aid Office prior to submitting this application, (3) be registered for at least one class for the upcoming semester, (4) be in good academic standing (not on warning, probation, or have any holds on my account), (5) return all necessary forms and attachments by the specified deadline.

I understand that: any scholarship funds awarded to me may be used **only** for tuition and/or fees; any funds awarded will be paid directly to NGTC and NO checks will be issued to me; scholarships will be awarded in an amount up to \$375 and only the amount billed to the Foundation through the NGTC Business Office will be paid; scholarship funds will not be used to reimburse me for any expenses I have paid out of pocket prior to being notified of scholarship award; Student Loan funds, WIOA, Veterans Benefits, etc. are considered Financial Aid and any funds I receive must be used to cover tuition and fees prior to my receiving scholarship funds; Foundation Scholarships are awarded on a semester by semester basis and that I must re-apply each semester if I need to obtain assistance through the NGTC Foundation.

I give permission to release to the NGTC Foundation all my academic history and financial aid information while a student at NGTC. This includes all grades at the end of each semester. Financial aid information will include the amount of grants, loans, scholarships, estimated family contribution, financial aid award letter, and any other information contained in my financial aid file held in the Office of Financial Aid. I understand that my name, if selected for a scholarship, may be publicized. I certify that all information I have provided on this form and in my essay is true and accurate.
