

**AMENDMENT ONE TO  
ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

On this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020 (the “Effective Date”), the Parties hereby agree as follows:

**WITNESSETH**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, by and on behalf of the University of North Georgia (the “University”), and North Georgia Technical College (the “College”) (each a “Party” and collectively, the “Parties”), entered into an Articulation Agreement on May 20, 2019 (“North Georgia Articulation Agreement”), and the Parties wish to amend that Agreement to reflect new course offerings by the College to facilitate transfers to the University; and;

**WHEREAS**, in January 2012, the University System of Georgia (“USG”) and the Technical College System of Georgia (“TCSG”) entered into an agreement known as the “Complete College Georgia Articulation Agreement” which identified core coursework which could be transferred between USG and TCSG institutions to avoid duplication of mission, using state resources efficiently and expanding opportunities for post-secondary attainment in Georgia; and;

**WHEREAS**, the Parties believe that establishing this cooperative articulation agreement at the College will allow for increased and efficient transfer opportunities for College students to the University; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed articulation contemplated by this Amendment complies with the requirements of USG and TCSG; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the terms and conditions set forth herein, both the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree to amend the Articulation Agreement as follows:

1. **Articulation and Requirements:** The University, in recognition of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (“SACSCOC”) accreditation of the College, hereby agrees to transfer the courses identified on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, from the College provided that the courses: (i) are taught by faculty as certified by SACSCOC standards; (ii) are completed with a passing grade, as determined by the University, by the student(s) seeking transfer; and (iii) have an appropriate corresponding course offering at the University.
2. **Understandings of the Parties:** Each Party will ensure that it maintains accreditation with the appropriate regional accrediting body and that all operations are in keeping with accreditation requirements. The University will transfer the courses listed on Exhibit A, as may be amended from time to time, into the appropriate business degree program, criminal justice program, or such other program as mutually agreed between the Parties from time to time.
3. **Modification:** This Amendment may be further amended or modified by written agreement of the Parties, duly signed by their authorized representatives. The Parties acknowledge and agree that additional courses for articulation are likely to be added to the list shown in Exhibit

A. The Parties agree that at any such time when additions or changes to courses approved for articulation are made, the Parties will amend Exhibit A by completing an updated list of courses and having it signed by a duly authorized representative of each Party. The Parties further agree to keep on file with this Agreement at all times throughout the Term a current copy of all courses approved for articulation according to this Agreement.


4. **Funds and Manpower:** This Agreement does not document nor provide for the exchange of funds or manpower between the Parties, nor does it make any commitment of funds or resources.
5. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts or through the exchange by facsimile or other electronic means of duly-signed duplicates hereof, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.


