**Step 2: Complete and submit an application.** (Distributed at overview sessions)

**NO SEMESTER DEADLINES FOR SUBMISSION.** Submit an application as soon as possible in order to maximize your benefits.

Applications will be processed ASAP. If an application is approved during a term, students will begin receiving funds for gas, childcare, and books/supplies that same term, with full benefits available the next term and for up to two years until program completion.

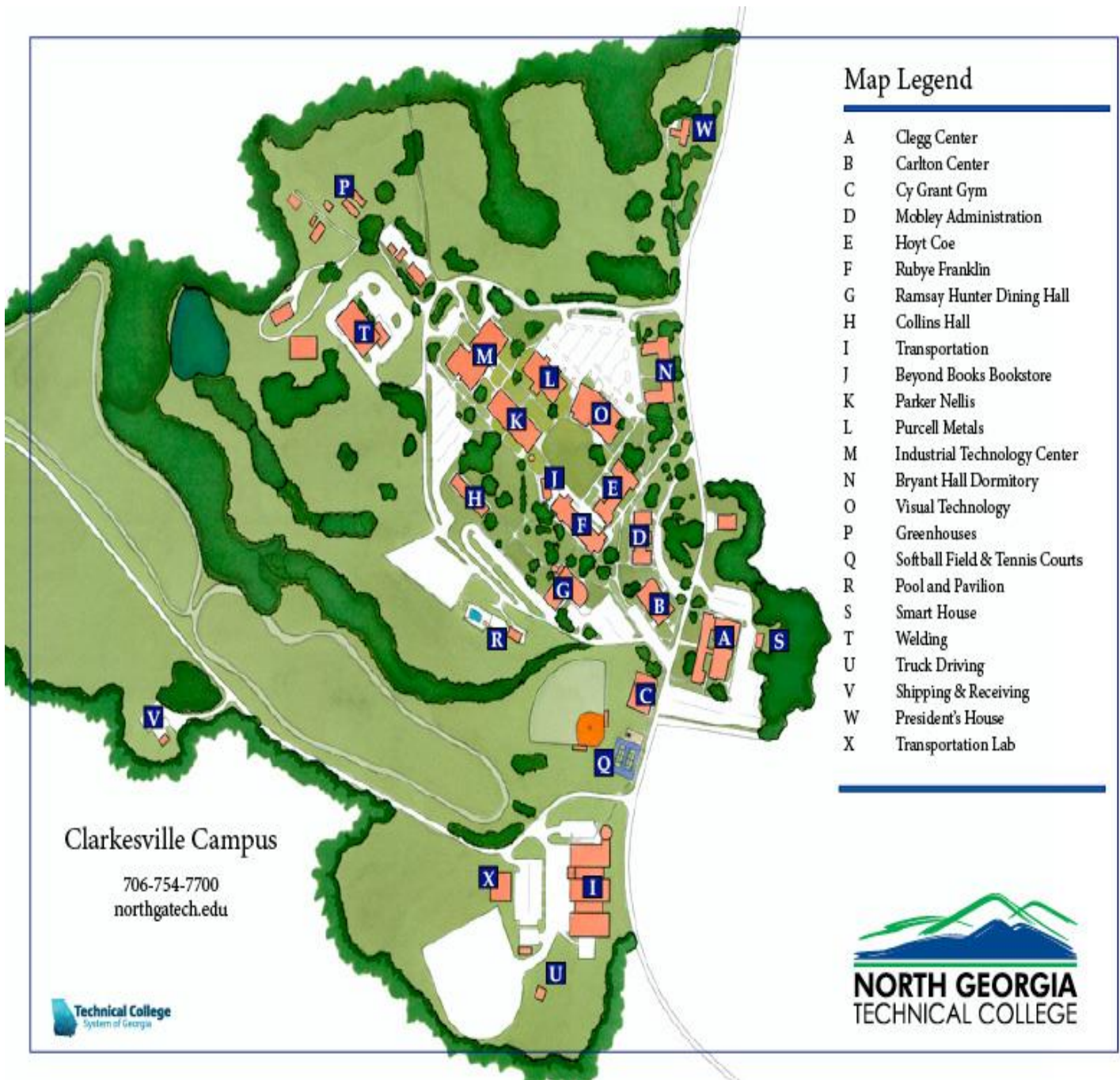
