AN AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH A TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN PIEDMONT COLLEGE AND NORTH GEORGIA TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Academic Years 2016 - 2021

This agreement establishes a plan whereby an undergraduate student that completes the *Criminal Justice Technology* program at North Georgia Technical College and receives an associate's degree (AAS) may transfer to Piedmont College to complete a bachelor's degree with a major in Criminal Justice.

Acceptance of Transfer Credits at Piedmont College

The following guidelines are used to award transfer credit:

- The transfer of credits is consistent with and subject to the conditions prescribed in each institution's published catalog at the time of the student's transfer request.
- Credit is transferable only for courses in which a grade of C or above is earned.
- Transferred courses must be comparable college-level courses judged to be equivalent in content and quality to Piedmont courses.
- Completion of the Criminal Justice Technology Program at North Georgia Technical College does
 not guarantee admission to Piedmont College. Candidates must successfully meet all
 requirements for admission to Piedmont College and the appropriate degree program.
- This agreement will be reviewed regularly by both parties to ensure continued transfer compatibility of courses, but will continue indefinitely until such time as it is dissolved by written request of either of the parties listed below.

Transfer students must complete all coursework necessary in their respective degree plan of study before receiving their bachelor's degree from Piedmont College. This agreement is subject to change, in order to comply with college requirements.
