## Toccoa Falls College and North Georgia Technical College Transfer Articulation

The purpose of this transfer articulation is to increase the awareness of educational opportunities for students of North Georgia Technical College, a SACSCOC accredited institution, through transfer of NGTC coursework to Toccoa Falls College. Toccoa Falls College desires to provide opportunities for North Georgia Technical College students to continue their education with maximum flexibility at the baccalaureate level.

North Georgia Technical College students wishing to transfer to Toccoa Falls College must meet all regular TFC admissions criteria. Credit will be transferred on a course by course basis and is subject to the general transfer credit practices as found in the TFC Catalog and the course equivalencies noted below. Insofar as possible, unnecessary repetition of course work should be avoided in the transfer process.

In planning their course schedules, NGTC students should consult the TFC Catalog for the anticipated major of their choice for specific core and major requirements. NGTC students should note that TFC's residency requirements include that in addition to the final 32 hours of a program, a minimum of 50% of major and minor hours must be taken through TFC. With minimum grades of C-, Toccoa Falls College will transfer the following North Georgia Technical College courses as the listed TFC equivalents.

The attached transfer articulation will be monitored periodically as curricular changes occur within the Technical College System of Georgia and Toccoa Falls College. Questions regarding the above transfer articulation should be directed to the Registrar's Office of Toccoa Falls College.
