Using combined knowledge of mechanical, electrical and automated systems technology, students operate, test, maintain and repair automated, robotic and electromechanical equipment. Graduates of the program receive an Advanced Manufacturing Systems degree or diploma that qualifies them for employment as industrial electricians, industrial systems technicians, robotic technicians or industrial mechanics.
