Are you interested in earning a degree, diploma or certificate? Do you want to receive an hourly wage and on-the-job training while completing school? Are you looking for a career path? If you answered yes to any of these questions, a Registered Apprenticeship might be the right fit for you.

North Georgia Technical College offers Registered Apprenticeship opportunities to qualified students. If you are selected, you will be hired as a full-time employee, attending classes on a part-time basis. When you complete the apprenticeship program, you will be awarded a U.S. DOL Certificate of Completion that shows you've had specialized training in your chosen occupation.



Some apprenticeship programs are eligible for 100% tuition coverage under the HOPE Career Grant.

A Registered Apprenticeship is an excellent way to earn competitive wages while learning a new skill set. The length of an apprenticeship varies depending on the employer, the complexity of the occupation, and the type of program. Apprentices who complete their program earn approximately \$300,000 more over their career compared to non-apprenticeship employees (U.S. Department of Labor).

Qualifications to be an Apprentice:

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Must meet NGTC admission requirements
- Must be physically able to perform the job for which you are hired
- Must meet other qualifications outlined by your employer
