Associate of Science in Nursing Degree available

NGTC's LPN to ASN Bridge program provides an opportunity for licensed practical nurses (LPNs) to earn an Associate of Science Degree in Nursing. The curriculum is designed to produce highly-trained, technically-advanced, competent, and caring individuals who are prepared to practice professional nursing in a variety of health care settings. Graduates of the LPN to ASN Bridge program who meet program requirements are eligible to apply and take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-RN and licensure, graduates are employable as registered nurses (RNs) in the state in which they intend to practice.

Students interested in admission to the LPN to ASN Bridge program must be admitted to NGTC, have a valid GA LPN license, obtain a minimum 3.0 GPA in the required core classes, take the HESI A2 exam on one of the NGTC campuses, and submit the online intent form.

For ASN graduates who wish to pursue a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN), NGTC has established articulation agreements with select four-year colleges to facilitate a student's transition from an ASN to BSN degree.
