NGTC's Medical Laboratory Technology program prepares students with the knowledge and skills necessary to become a competent MLT and to perform medical laboratory procedures under the supervision of a qualified medical laboratory scientist. This is accomplished through select academic and occupational courses as well as hands-on training in basic laboratory skills; math and computer skills; phlebotomy; urinalysis and body fluids; clinical chemistry; microbiology and parasitology; immunohematology; and more. A variety of clinical experiences are also planned so that theory and practice are integrated under the guidance of clinical preceptors. NGTC's Medical Laboratory program is accredited by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Science.

The Medical Laboratory Technology program is designed to prepare students to sit for the national certification exam recognized by the Georgia Department of Human Services and to work as a MLT in a variety of high-complexity medical laboratories including:
